

Extreme Slo-Pitch League 2020

Do's & Don't's

Mens/Coed/Ladies/3 Pitch Divisions

All Team Reps, Please read then print and sign below.

This sheet must be handed in with your league fees.

- All team reps, players coaches and staff must adhere to the rules outlined by our governing body Slo-Pitch Ontario or otherwise stated by the Extreme Slo-Pitch League.
- All team reps must sign and date the Code of Conduct.
- No drinking of alcohol while participating in league play. Any player drinking will be ejected by the umpire. Also the team rep will be ejected as well.
- All doubleheader games for mens/coed and ladies games will have a 1 and 1 count and all games will have a time limit of 60 minutes.
- 3 pitch games will have a time limit of 70 minutes
- All single coed games will have a time limit of 70 minutes and will have a 1 and 1 count for all batters.
- Team reps must send in their initial roster prior to May 1 of the current playing season thru the online portal on the Extreme website.
- Team reps must pay the full league fees by June 1. Deposit and Registration form due by April 15.
- Team reps must have control of their players throughout the season during league play.
- Team reps must advise by email if they need a certain night off because of a team wedding, team vacations or teams participating in the Provincials. All requests must be sent 45 days prior to the scheduled date.
- Weather Report. Rain - please don't call the league line and ask if the games are going to be played on your night. If it rains all day then a decision will be made by 4pm. Please have your players check the website on the first page to see if the night is cancelled. If it starts raining after 4 pm then your team MUST show up to the diamonds.
- Balls/Score sheets - all teams must keep their score sheets intact. Balls given to you at the start of the season are only for league and 3 playoff games. Moving forward if you want more balls to finish off the playoffs then please contact the league office to arrange pickup for your semi's and finals. All teams must have a new ball and a used ball for every home game including playoffs. Balls available at the Extreme office. See hours of operation below. Balls also available at the CAA Centre Pro Shop.
- All teams reps must submit scores at the end of each night of play. Not just the home team but both teams each night thru the scores portal on the website.
- SPO INSURANCE. We pay your insurance for your team at the start of the season. But to be insured, all teams reps must input their players on the SPO database. You will get a username and password from SPO sometime in late June for you to have access online. All players then will go online as well with their own username and password and complete the insurance enrolment. All players must be active on the SPO website. You as a team rep are liable so please make sure all payers are "ACTIVE" . Any issues please call Kerri at the SPO office 905-646-7773. Your team will be registered by June 15 with the SPO office.
- All players must be in uniform by June 1. They must have a team jersey with at least a 4 inch number. Any player not in uniform, we assume are not on the roster therefore are not insured. Govern yourself accordingly.
- All rosters are frozen on July 15. No Player shall be added to the roster unless noted by the league executive.

- All players must play 25% of games during the regular season to be eligible for the playoffs and must be insured and ACTIVE on the SPO website.
- It is suggested to have at least 14 full time players on your team and can have as many as 24 players on the roster so please load up the roster at the start of the season.
- **NEW NEW NEW SO PLEASE READ CAREFULLY! – Any team that defaults any game or games will be charged \$75.00 per game. If it’s a doubleheader then your team will be charged \$125.00. Way too many teams are bailing because of their work schedule or injuries or any other reason. You need to make sure your team is ready to play each week. NO MORE DEFAULTS or pay up. Teams that show up are upset so the fee will be due ASAP to the league office and reimbursed 100% to the other team involved. All Default fees must be paid within 48 Hours or your team will not be scheduled whatsoever until fees are confirmed PAID!**
- No vehicles will be allowed to drive on the grass at anytime.
- For all diamonds except for the CAA Diamond, your team must bring bases and a mat to every game night. failure to do so may result in a double forfeit. No bases no Play even if you are not the home team.
- Teams must vacate the dugouts right away so they then can get the later game times to start play.
- EARLY INCENTIVE DRAW - Each year we have an incentive draw to get the league fees in by a certain dates. Prizes are currently posted on the website at www.extremeslopitch.com. All teams that adhere to the following dates and will be placed in the draw which will be held on April 23, 2020. Team rep must have their registration form and a deposit of \$400.00 by February 13, 2020. They then must have their full and final payment by April 16, 2020.
- Any team not participating in the draw must have 50% of their league fees in by April 23 or your team will not be scheduled.
- Schedules will be released by April 30 as the season starts Friday May 1, 2020.
